The Kenora Nordic trail system is located in Kenora ON, approximately 200km east of Winnipeg. We have over 20 km of beautiful ski trails that offer both classic and skate skiers the chance to experience the magnificent Canadian Boreal Forest. All trails are groomed for classic skiing and 7 km of trails also

accommodate skate skiing. The Kenora Nordic Trails are suited for

all skill levels from beginner to expert.

RACE FORMAT: Saturday race is Classic technique – random draw, interval start.

This means racers will start individually (possible option for two at a

time) at a pre-set time (start list will be posted Friday Feb 11th).

Sunday race is <u>Free technique</u> – interval start based on race times

from the Saturday race. If you enter only Sunday's race your seeding will be determined based on past race times. Free

technique means you may use classic technique if you wish. More

INTERVAL CLASSIC: As per the FIS rule 343.8.1 poles must be no more than 83%

of the racer's height in ski boots. This measurement is from the pole strap insertion to the tip of the pole. Poles may be measured **prior to the race start**. Racers are reminded to

give additional time for this to occur.

COURSE MAPS: Available and posted at race site and at end of this notice.

Course closes 8 pm Friday night for final prep.

MB CUP POINTS: All CCSAM Club members earn points for their club based on

placing in each race and on the distance travelled to participate.

CONTINGENCY PLAN:

This race has been postponed from February. No further postponement plan is in place.

Race Time Temp cut off is -15 C for all athletes under 10 years. Race temp for all other categories is -20 C.

REFUND POLICY:

Race fees are not refundable in the event of postponement. Race fees will be refunded, minus an administration fee, if the race is cancelled outright.

A refund of registration fees will only be provided for medical reasons prior to the registration deadline of Feb 9, 2022.

WAXING:

Mt Evergreen Ski Area: Friday-Sunday

- 1. KNBC Wax Hut (2 built in wax forms): Capacity limited to 1 family or "COVID" bubble at a time.
- 2. Mt Evergreen Garage (Saturday and Sunday only):

Please come self-sufficient for waxing – BYO wax form/table, extension cord etc. There will be a test track and warm up track. COVID guidelines enforced in this space.

WAXING PROTOCOL:

CCSAM respectfully requests ALL athletes, coaches, wax technicians and parents to abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for all CCSAM-sanctioned events. This is an outright ban on fluorinated waxes. In November 2019, the FIS Council decided to ban the use of fluorinated waxes because it has been shown they have a negative impact on the health of people working with the wax and on the environment.

This protocol applies to ALL local, regional and provincial events taking place in Manitoba (and in all Nordiq Canada &/or FIS sanctioned competitions when applicable). CHANGE FACILITY:

Limited indoor capacity for changing will be available due to COVID protocols. Racers are encouraged to arrive to the race site in race clothing. Racers will not be able to leave equipment or clothing in the chalet. Use of vehicles for warming and changing as needed. A warming tent is available near the start in the stadium. Capacity limits apply.

AWARDS:

Bring your tablets and devices! Join us at 7 pm on Saturday evening for a Day 1 awards presentation. All medals will be mailed to Club representatives following the race weekend. Zoom link will be provided with registration confirmation. To enhance the experience for all, connect early, use your mute button wisely, use the chat function to


