REFUND POLICY:	Race fees are not refundable in the event of postponement. Race fees will be refunded, minus an administration fee, if the race is cancelled outright. A refund of registration fees will only be provided for medical reasons prior to the registration deadline of Feb 8, 2023. Meal fees are not refundable
WAXING:	We suggest you arrive with your skis glide waxed. Shannondale has limited wax space in Quonset/garage in parking lot. Please come self-sufficient for waxing – BYO wax form/table, extension cord etc.

PROTOCOL:	CCSAM respectfully requests ALL athletes, coaches, wax technicians and parents to abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for all CCSAM-sanctioned events.
	This is an outright ban on fluorinated waxes because it has been shown they have a negative impact on the health of people working with the wax and on the environment.
	This protocol applies to ALL local, regional and provincial events taking place in Manitoba (and in all Nordiq Canada &/or FIS sanctioned competitions when applicable).
	This protocol is applicable to ALL age and race categories.
	The adherence to this protocol is self-governed and is the responsibility of the athletes, coaches, parents and wax technicians.
AWARDS:	Provincial medal ceremony will take place after Banquet on Saturday at approx. 7:30pm
	Sunday medal ceremony will take place immediately after racing using unofficial results
	Provincial medals are awarded to CCSAM Club members in U10 through Master age categories for each race day. Recreational skiers, U8 & non-CCSAM members are not eligible for Provincial medals.
	All participants are eligible for draw prizes, provided by our sponsors, awarded during the Banquet on Saturday and you must be present to win.
